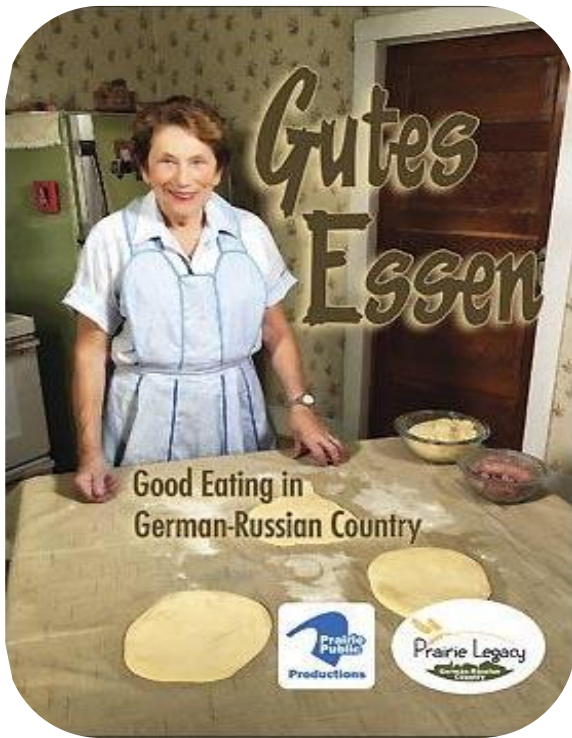

Many of you may know the cooks and recipes featured in the cookbook, but even if you do not, you will recognize the dishes that are sure to bring back memories of time spent in your mother's or grandmother's kitchen either helping in the preparation or enjoying with family and friends around the table. Adding this cookbook to your own collection or gifting a copy to family members is a wonderful way to preserve our German-Russian heritage for future generations. What an amazing way to teach your children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren how to prepare traditional German-Russian foods or to share your memories.



### **Included German-Russian Recipes:**

*Strudels* – so thin you could read a love letter

*Knephla* – in soup or with sauerkraut

*Stumbus* – root vegetable mash

*Bladgenda* – with sweet or savory pumpkin filling

*Borscht* – harvest vegetable soup with or without beets

*Hot Potato Salad* – a warm sugar and vinegar favorite

*Fleischkuechla* – meat “meets” pastry crust

*Sauerkraut* – sour canned cabbage for any German meal

*Stirrum* – chopped up pancake served with syrup or cream

*Kuchen* – wedding style or with fruit and custard style

*Rahmnoodle* – another kuchen like dough with custard

*Pickled everything* – from beets to watermelon to eggs or most anything including pigs feet

*Wedding schnapps* – party in a shot glass, not made for sipping

*Homemade Noodles* – for soup or any pasta dish

*Potato Bread* – can make any meal for 10 serve 20
